**Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo Hun Sen
Concluded Official and Goodwill Visit to China**

Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN Sen, President of the Cambodian People's Party (CPP) and President of the Senate of the Kingdom of Cambodia concluded with fruitful outcomes his official and goodwill visit to the People's Republic of China, from 2 to 4 December 2024. During this visit he had separate meetings with His Excellency XI Jinping, General Secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China (CPC) and President of the People's Republic of China, His Excellency Wang Huning, Chairman of the National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference, and His Excellency ZHAO Leji, Chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress of China.

Samdech Techo Hun Sen applauded the remarkable progress of China in every field as the country celebrates its 75th founding anniversary this year. Samdech Techo and the Chinese leaders shared great satisfaction with the steady advancement of Cambodia-China Comprehensive Strategic Partnership of Cooperation. They emphasized the importance of further fostering mutual political trust between Cambodia and China, through maintaining frequent high-level exchanges between the ruling parties, the governments and the legislative bodies of the two countries. Samdech Techo Hun Sen reaffirmed Cambodia's unwavering adherence to the One China Policy and thanked the Chinese Leaders for supporting Cambodia's development path that is suitable for the country's national context.

Samdech Techo Hun Sen expressed deep appreciation to the Chinese leaders for their pledge to continue contributing to Cambodia's sustainable growth through effective implementation of the Action Plan on Building a Cambodia-China Community with a Shared Future in the New Era (2024-2028), and the Diamond Hexagon Cooperation Framework, focusing on six priority areas - political cooperation, production capacity, and quality, agriculture, energy, security, and people-to-people exchanges. Techo Hun Sen and the Chinese leaders touched on expediting the realization of the "Industrial and Technological Corridor" and the "Fish and Rice Corridor" in Cambodia. They also agreed to expand cooperation in education and increase tourism, cultural and youth exchanges.

On defence and security, Samdech Techo and the Chinese leaders highlighted the necessity of strengthening cooperation against online scam, human and drug trafficking, and other transnational crimes, in order to ensure national harmony and security of the two countries. They expressed shared commitment to enhance cooperation under regional and international frameworks to safeguard the core interests of both nations and promote multilateral cooperation for peace, security, stability and prosperities within the region and the world at large.

Samdech Techo Hun Sen extended a cordial invitation to the Chinese leaders to visit Cambodia, and hope to welcome each of them in Phnom Penh in the near future. While in Beijing, Samdech Techo Hun Sen visited the National Administrative School of the CPC Central Committee and the CPC History Museum.

Preceding this visit of Samdech Techo Hun Sen, His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister Prak Sokhonn, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, concluded his visit in Beijing from 28 November to 01 December 2024. His Excellency Prak Sokhonn had separate meetings and fruitful discussions with His Excellency Wang Yi, Minister of Foreign Affairs of China and His Excellency Minister Liu Jianchao, Head of the CPC's International Department, on ways and means to strengthen and expand Cambodia-China relations and multifaceted cooperation.
