His Excellency **Prak Sokhonn**, Senior Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia, will lead a delegation to attend the 13<sup>th</sup> ASEM Foreign Ministers' Meeting (ASEM FMM) on 20-21 November 2017 in Nay Pyi Taw, Myanmar, at the invitation of Her Excellency **Daw Aung San Suu Kyi**, State Counsellor and Union Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar.

The 13<sup>th</sup> ASEM FMM bearing the theme "Strengthening Partnership for Peace and Sustainable Development", will provide a unique opportunity to explore possible ways and means of enhancing partnership for the promotion of peace, harmony, development and prosperity throughout Asia and Europe.

During his participation in the above said meeting, His Excellency Senior Minister **Prak Sokhonn** will sign with His Excellency **U Kyaw Tin**, Minister of State for Foreign Affairs of Myanmar, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar on political consultations.

In addition, His Excellency Senior Minister **Prak Sokhonn** will also hold bilateral meetings with Her Excellency **Daw Aung San Suu Kyi**, State Counsellor and Union Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, His Excellency **Wang Yi**, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China, His Excellency **Kazuyuki Nakane**, State Minister of Foreign Affairs of Japan, and other heads of delegation of some countries.

It should be noted that Cambodia became a member of ASEM on the occasion of the 5<sup>th</sup> ASEM Summit in Hanoi, Viet Nam, on 08 October 2004 and was ASEM coordinator for ASEAN from 2008 to 2010.
