Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN SEN, Prime Minister of the Government of the Kingdom of Cambodia, will lead a high-level delegation to attend the "Informal Dialogue between APEC and ASEAN Leaders", to be held on 10 November 2017, in Da Nang city, at the invitation of His Excellency Mr. Tran Dai Quang, President of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam.

The delegation will include His Excellency Mr. Pan Sorasak, Minister of Commerce, His Excellency Dr. Hang Chuon Naron, Minister of Education, Youth and Sports, and other members of the Government of the Kingdom of Cambodia.

Under the theme "Partnering for New Dynamism for a Comprehensively Connected and Integrated Asia-Pacific", the Informal Dialogue between APEC and ASEAN Leaders will provide an excellent opportunity to explore ways for fresh cooperation between these two regional mechanisms in promoting peace and prosperity.

Cambodia, as a non-member of APEC, has supported the initiative to create a platform for dialogue between ASEAN and APEC Leaders in the understanding that these two important regional architectures should be complementary to each other in shaping the future of the region.

During his stay in Viet Nam, Samdech Techo will pay a courtesy call on His Excellency Tran Dai Quang, President of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam, and attend a working breakfast hosted by His Excellency Nguyen Xuan Phuc, Prime Minister of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam.

It should be noted that Samdech Techo Prime Minister attended the "APEC Dialogue on Strengthening Connectivity Partnership" and the "APEC Chief Executive Officer Summit" held from 7-9 November 2014 in Beijing, the People's Republic of China.
