Thus, Cambodia is proud and indeed privileged to host this meeting at the important juncture where we are about to move from a very humble nurturing stage to an "**Expansion Stage**" marked by an ambitious agenda of partnership and cooperation.

For Cambodia, this 2nd Leaders' Meeting is deeply significant; and it is not by coincidence that we have chosen the theme: "**Our River of Peace and Sustainable Development**". **Sustained Peace and Long-Term Sustainable Development** must exist and move forward together. Also I am pleased to take note that the 3rd LMC Foreign Ministers' Meeting held last month in **Dali**, 132 projects have been approved as the First Batch of Projects of LMC Special Fund 2017 and another list of Projects of LMC Special Fund with 214 projects has been submitted for our evaluation. Clearly, this is one of the most tangible and defining characteristic of the MLC being a "**Project/Cooperation-Based Mechanism**", and not a mere "**Talk-Shop**".

So far, we have mobilized our political will, we have combined our economic strengths, we have exploited our regional complementarity to promote our respective country development and re-invigorate our sub-regional growth in the spirit of our MLC Way, which is very much along our well-known ASEAN Way. We have found great synergy in effectively mirroring the three key areas of cooperation of the LMC with the 3 pillars of the ASEAN Community.
