Cambodia, Türkiye Highly Value Relations and Productive Cooperation

His Excellency Prak Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, and Her Excellency Ülkü Kocaefe, new Ambassador of the Republic of Türkiye to Cambodia, appreciated with satisfaction the existing excellent friendship and good cooperation between the two countries during a courtesy call by the Envoy on 01 September 2022. Ambassador Ülkü Kocaefe conveyed to Deputy PM Prak Sokhonn the greetings and best wishes from H.E. Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Türkiye while the Deputy PM recalled his recent fruitful visit to Türkiye and the participation of Türkiye's Foreign Minister in the recent 55th ASEAN Foreign Ministers' Meeting (AMM) and Related Meetings in Phnom Penh.

Deputy PM Prak Sokhonn and Ambassador Ülkü Kocaefe noted with satisfaction some positive factors that will open the way for the boosting of trade relations, which have not yet met the two countries potentials, among them the decision of Turkish government to establish the Office of the Counsellor for Commercial Affairs in the Türkiye's Embassy in Phnom Penh, the entry into force of the Agreement on Reciprocal Promotion and Protection of Investment, the signing of the Agreement on Avoidance of Double Taxation, as well as the 3rd meeting of Joint Economic Commission to be held in Cambodia on 19-20 October 2022.

The Deputy PM and the new Envoy also discussed ways to tap into new areas for cooperation and agreed to expedite the conclusion of some pending documents needed to further enhance the bilateral cooperation. The Deputy Prime Minister
