At the invitation of His Excellency MOTEGI Toshimitsu, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Japan, His Excellency PRAK Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia, will participate in the 14<sup>th</sup> Mekong-Japan Foreign Ministers' Meeting which will be held on 06 August 2021, via video conference.

The Meeting will be chaired by Japan and will also be participated by Foreign Ministers from other Mekong countries namely Lao PDR, Myanmar, Thailand and Viet Nam.

The Mekong-Japan Foreign Ministers will review the progress of the Mekong-Japan cooperation in various areas, set out future direction of this cooperation for promoting sustainable development, enhancing social, economic and cultural interconnections among Mekong countries and Japan, and realizing a more vibrant Mekong sub-region, in light of the COVID-19 pandemic and emerging challenges. They will also exchange views on regional and international issues of common interests and concerns.
