"Outcomes of a Courtesy Call on His Excellency SOK Chenda Sophea,

Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation,

by His Excellency Martin Vávra, Ambassador of the Czech Republic

to the Kingdom of Cambodia"

His Excellency SOK Chenda Sophea, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, received a courtesy call from His Excellency Martin Vávra, Ambassador of the Czech Republic to the Kingdom of Cambodia, on 31 October 2023.

The two sides recalled the traditional close bonds of excellent friendship and cooperation between Cambodia and the Czech Republic on the basis of mutual trust and understanding. They expressed deep satisfaction with increased bilateral cooperation and reiterated their steadfast commitment to further promote exchanges of high-level visits and partnerships in trade and investment to greater heights for the mutual benefit of the two nations.

His Excellency the Deputy Prime Minister conveyed deep gratitude to the Czech government for its assistance to Cambodia which has contributed to socio-economic development, including in education and health. Emphasizing the importance of diversifying production, he encouraged Czech investors in other ASEAN countries to consider Cambodia as an investment destination.

His Excellency Vávra shared the views of His Excellency the Deputy Prime Minister on the good relations between the two countries and affirmed his commitment to make better use of existing potentials. On that note, he emphasized the need to attract Czech investors to Cambodia through promotional activities, especially in health care and education.
